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OncoEMR™ Receives Ohio State Board of Pharmacy Approval for ePrescribing *Oncologists in Ohio Practices Have OncoEMR ePrescribing Use*

Los Altos, California—October 31, 2011—Altos Solutions, Inc. today announced that the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy approved the electronic prescription transmission system within OncoEMR™ Version 2.6, a web-based oncology-specific electronic medical record (EMR). OncoEMR is the first web-based and full oncology-specific EMR in which the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy has provided approval status for the ePrescribing system. The Ohio State Board of Pharmacy regulations for ePrescribing are stringent specifications that require positive identification within the electronic prescription process. All Ohio practices installed with OncoEMR are approved to use ePrescribing directly from within OncoEMR. OncoEMR provides ePrescribing with SureScripts® certified functionality for fast, secure prescribing. With ePrescribing directly within OncoEMR, the oncologist's workflow is enhanced, which further enables oncologists to streamline their ePrescribing to meet a meaningful use threshold. OncoEMR was the first oncology-specific EMR to be certified* as 2011/2012 compliant and was certified as a Complete EHR on November 11, 2010 by the Certification Commission for Health Information Technology (CCHIT®), an ONC-ATCB, in accordance with the applicable eligible provider certification criteria adopted by the Secretary of Health and Human Services. The 2011/2012 criteria support the Stage 1 meaningful use measures required to qualify eligible providers and hospitals for funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

Oncologists using OncoEMR in Ohio now have a significant advantage in receiving stimulus incentive dollars with OncoEMR use that includes the pharmacy board approval of ePrescribing within the application. To be eligible for ARRA incentive funding, eligible providers must use certified EHR technology and successfully attest to meeting meaningful use measures.

Prior approval by the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy is required in Ohio practices for all electronic prescription transmissions. The Board's approval process of electronic prescription transmission within OncoEMR included reviewing that OncoEMR has true positive identification of the prescriber sending the prescription, OncoEMR has security and accountability of all confidential information, the pharmacist receiving the prescription can identify that OncoEMR has approvable status with the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy, and the pharmacist receiving the prescription can identify that the prescription is legitimate.

"We made a firm commitment to our Ohio customers that Altos Solutions would deliver OncoEMR as approved for electronic prescription transmission. I'm thrilled to announce that today we accomplished that goal," stated Carla Wood, president of Altos Solutions. "Not only is OncoEMR the first certified oncology-specific EMR, we also are the
